(b) The molecular formula, CH_4 , gives the number of each kind of atom Follow steps 1-3 as given in the student textbook Step 1 Carbon has the lower electronegativity in the molecule and will be the central atom Step 2 Find the total number of valence electrons ($1 \text{ atom C} \times 4e^-/\text{C}$) + ($4 \text{ atoms H} \times 1e^-/\text{H}$) = $8e^-$ Determine the total number of electrons required for a noble gas
